



TWO ISLANDS RYC - CLUB RULES

1. All persons sailing on Furzton Lake must be members or guests of the Club.
2. When one or more members and/or guests are sailing on the Furzton Lake this is classed as a Club activity. Members and guests using the lake should remain in the designated sailing area and care should be taken when moving around the sailing area particularly when the ground is slippery. All equipment must be kept clear of the footpaths and walkways.
3. The Club accepts no responsibility for persons or equipment using the Furzton Lake facilities.
4. All members must obey the Safety Rules
 - a. A buoyancy aid must be worn when using the dinghy.
 - b. A second member must be in attendance when using the dinghy and one person should remain on the bank.
 - c. No person under the age of 18 is allowed to use the dinghy. Any person under 18 should be supervised by a responsible adult at all times
 - d. No swimming or bathing is allowed in Furzton Lake.
 - e. Care must be taken when using the dinghy, no sharp objects are to be placed in the dinghy, soft shoes are to be worn, buoy weights are to be placed in container provided and not placed directly onto the dinghy skin.
 - f. Any open wounds or abrasions should be covered before making contact with water from the lake
 - g. Hands should be washed, or covered, after coming into contact with water from the lake before handling food.
5. Members should refrain from dropping, or leaving, their litter at the lake.
6. Members should not do anything that may become a nuisance or annoyance to the owners of any neighbouring premises.
7. Extendable aerials must have some form of protection on the end to reduce the risk of injury to others.
8. All members must ensure that no damage is done to the site.
9. No power vessels are allowed to use the lake.
10. All vehicles should use the designated car park.
11. All members are required to fulfil duties as Racing Officials as and when required.
12. All members and guests are to abide by all bylaws and regulations relating to the Club area.



13. Any member behaving in such a way likely to cause offence or embarrassment to other members or the general public during Club activities will be warned by the committee that his/her actions are to be modified. If no improvement is observed within four weeks then he/she will be asked by the committee to resign or be expelled from the Club
14. In the event of the Club being faced with an unexpected expense not covered by existing funds the excess amount will be collected from the members on an equal basis.
15. Failure to obey any of the Club Rules may result in a member's suspension or expulsion.
